Once complete, coordinate with a supervisor to complete the in-person skills check-off. NREMT's may apply 4 hours of CEU's towards their 2-year recertification cycle.

# Rescue Watercraft (RWC) Training (40 hours / 24 hours)

Rookies must attend 40 hours of RWC Training. Returners must attend 24 hours of recurring training annually.

# Beach Emergency Vehicle Operations (BEVO) Training (24 hours / 16 hours)

NREMT's may apply 8 hours of CEU's towards their 2-year recertification cycle.
